This newsletter is to remind you about the Guided Walk through Stockbridge next week and to give you a report on the AGM.

The **Guided Walk** is on Friday 18th June, starting at 7.00 pm and finishing at about 8.30 pm; or maybe a little before. The walk is being led by Don Bryan, who is a professional Tour Guide and who came and gave a talk last year about the River Test. The walk starts from the old church adjacent to the White Hart Inn at the Winchester end of the High Street; so please meet at the small car park at the front of the pub. We are hoping to get access to both Stockbridge churches; although this is still to be confirmed.

For the walk, we have **7 places waiting to be reserved**; so if you haven't yet booked there is still time to return the form at the bottom of this letter.

We held a successful **AGM** on May 15th. The formal meeting lasted about 40 minutes and was followed by a **Picture Quiz**. There were five teams competing for a prize and final scores for the top three teams were very close indeed. All photographs in the Quiz were local to Wherwell and Fullerton; some were easy and a few were quite challenging. A copy of the Quiz is attached to this newsletter, so those that missed the AGM can test their local knowledge at home. The AGM re-elected the same Officers and Committee as last year, and approved an increase in Membership Subscription to £12. A committee of six is very small; and we repeat our plea for more help with the Scrapbook project; either by taking photographs, adding captions to photographs and especially help with the creation of one-page Profiles of people connected to the village and with village life.
